The club owns two disks that you can use to print off stamp album pages from any country that produces stamps. (For example, if you collect a few British colonies, but not all of them, you can print just the ones that interest you.) Pages can be printed on 8 1/2" x 11" paper (cardstock works great). Club members can borrow disks for free from Ken Rehfeld, but they must be returned by the next meeting.


These are just a few of the many famous women on US stamps. Do you know why these women are famous?
