The club is always looking for speakers who are willing to give a program. Consider doing a short presentation about one of your collecting interests. Contact Jeff Wills to volunteer.


# Print your own stamp album pages

(For example, if you collect a few British colonies, but not all of them, you can print just the ones that interest you.) Pages can be printed on 8 1/2" x 11" paper (cardstock works great). Club members can borrow disks for free from Ken Rehfeld, but they must be returned by the next meeting.
