June 26 Post Office Tour

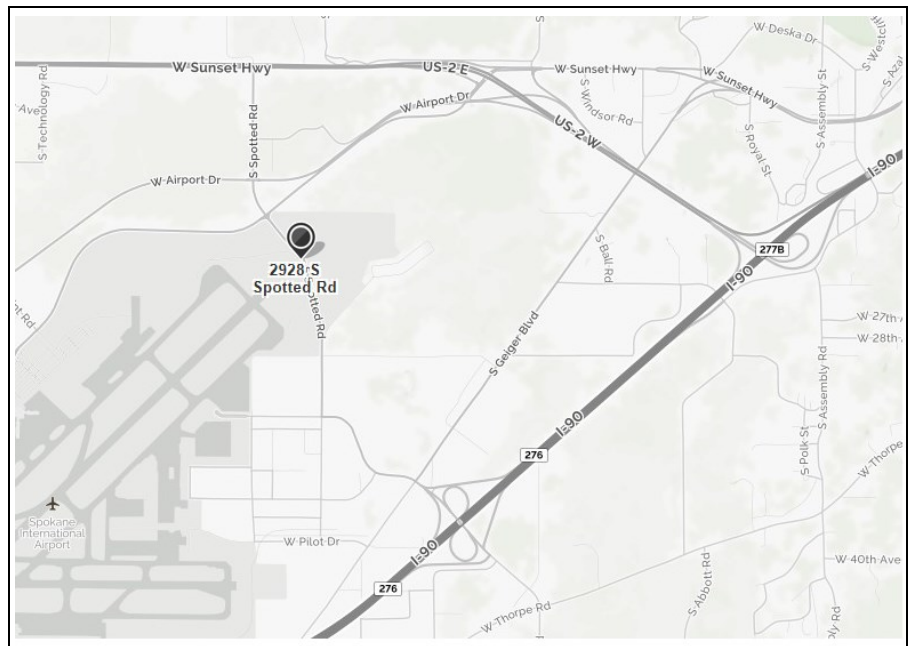
