

October 22, Post Office Tour



There will be no meeting at the Eagles this month, and we will instead meet for a tour of the main Spokane Post Office at 904 W. Riverside.

The federal government acquired the West Riverside Avenue and Lincoln Street site in 1903 for a cost of \$100,000. James Knox Taylor, Supervising Architect of the U.S. Treasury Department, designed the building in 1906-07.

Construction began in 1908 and was completed in 1909.

- Location: Main Spokane Post Office at 904 W. Riverside
- <u>Parking</u>: Metered, on-street parking on Riverside (in front of the Spokane Club), on Madison, or on Lincoln. There are also nearby parking garages, including the one in River Park Square (enter from Spokane Falls Blvd., across from City Hall)
