

### **March 23 Zoom Meeting Notes**

Thanks to Myron Molnau for the great program that he gave on the Canada 1928-30 Scroll Issue at our March Zoom meeting. We had a good turnout, with people coming and going throughout the meeting. People from other clubs also attended the meeting, including Ron Cone, president of the Tri-Cities Stamp Club, and Vera Felts from the Strait Stamp Society, who is a former executive director of the American Topical Association.

Scott English, the Executive Director of the American Philatelic Society, also attended. He said that he often attends Zoom meetings for clubs around the country, and that between 100 and 120 APS member clubs are currently holding Zoom meetings. He said that planning is under way for the APS Great American Stamp Show in Chicago this August. The show isn't definite at this point, but they hope to know by mid May whether it will be held. Scott said that APS membership is growing with more people joining than a year ago. More collectors seem to be spending time on stamps—perhaps due in part to the pandemic. He also put in a plug for the *Philatelic Literature Review*, published by the American Philatelic Research Library, which is associated with the APS.
