US Postage Rates Increasing?

On April 10 the US Postal Service filed a notice with the Postal Regulatory Commission (PRC) of price changes that will increase on July 9. If approved by the PRC, the first class rate will increase 3 cents from 63 cents to 66 cents. This will be the second price increase in 2023. The rate rose from 60 cents to 63 cents on January 22.
