WHEN COLLECTING COVERS, I HAVE BEEN TOLD THAT THEY SHOULD CONTAIN AT LEAST 3 INDIVIDUAL FEATURES. I THINK THIS COVER DOES THAT. 1ST: A SPECIAL DELIVERY STAMP IS USED ALONG WITH REGULAR POSTAGE. THE CANCEL IS NEW YORK WHICH COINCIDES WITH THE CORNER. IN ADDITION, BOTH STAMPS ARE PERFINED. THE "NKF" PERFIN(1902-18) IS THE PATTERN FOR "THE N.K. FAIRBANK CO." 2ND: THIS IS AN ADVERTISING COVER FOR THAT COMPANY. THE N.K FAIRBANK COMPANY WAS KNOWN FOR ITS

SOAP, ANIMAL AND BAKING PRODUCTS. 3RD: THE CACHET HAS TWO BOYS(BLACK AMERICANA) CLEANING THE SIGN AND A BOX OF WASHING POWDER IN THE LOWER RIGHT. THE TWO BOYS PICTURED ARE KNOWN AS THE "GOLD DUST" TWINS. GOLD DUST WASHING POWDER WAS ONE OF THE MOST SUCCESSFUL CLEANSING PRODUCT LINES IN TWENTIETH CENTURY NORTH AMERICA. LEVER BROTHERS DISTRIBUTED THE PRODUCT.
